Objective of the program:

A thermal method of analysis is a technique in which measure a physical property of a material as we subject it to a change in temperature. In this chapter we consider three examples of thermal methods: thermogravimetry, differential thermal analysis, and differential scanning calorimetry.

Thermal methods of analysis include a group of techniques in which change in physical property of a material is measured as a function of temperature while the substance is subjected to a controlled temperature programme.

In modern era the new materials are studied with respect tocomposition, stability, chemical reactions and dynamic properties.

Thermal methods are useful for the sekind of analysis.

These methods also provide information about the structure, composition, purity and the temperature phase change of a material.

Objectives:

Thermal analysis is a general term defining a technique used to analyze the time and temperature at which physical changes occur when a substance is heated or cooled. Each technique is defined according to the types of physical changes being analyzed. Thermal analysis methods are normally used to monitor endothermic processes (melting, boiling, sublimation, vaporization, desolvation, solid-solid phase transitions, and chemical
