Objective of the program:

The goal of all sophisticated drug delivery systems, therefore, is to deploy medications intact to specifically targeted parts of the body through a medium that can control the therapy's administration by means of either a physiological or chemical trigger. To achieve this goal, researchers are turning to advances in the worlds of micro- and nanotechnology. During the past decade, polymeric microspheres, polymer micelles, and hydrogel-type materials have all been shown to be effective in enhancing drug targeting specificity, lowering systemic drug toxicity, improving treatment absorption rates, and providing protection for

Pha accuticals against biochemical degradation. In addition, several other experimental drug delivery systems show exciting signs of promise, including those composed of biodegradable polymers, dendrimers (so-called star polymers), electroactive polymers, and modified C-60 fullerenes (also known as "buckyballs").

Outcome of the program

The technologies described here obviously represent little more than the tip of the iceberg for the development of drug delivery systems, and few of these even extend beyond the realm of benchtop experimentation. Although these approaches are the focus of intense, ongoing research, other processes are also under consideration, including aerosol inhalation devices, transdermal methodologies, forced pressure injectables, and biodegradable polymer networks designed specifically to transport new gene therapies. Many of these advances are at the very least predicated on the technologies just described.

The need for research into drug delivery systems extends beyond ways to administer new pharmaceutical therapies; the safety and efficacy of current treatments may be improved if their delivery rate, biodegradation, and site-specific targeting can be predicted, monitored, and controlled. From both a financial and a global health care perspective, finding ways to administer injectable-only medications in oral form and delivering costly. multiple-dose, long-term therapies in inexpensive, potent, and time-releasing or self-triggering formulations are also needed. The promise of administration methods that allow patients to safely treat themselves is as significant as any other health care development, particularly in developing countries where doctors, clean syringes, sterile needles, and sophisticated treatments are few and far between.

However, this will require surmounting novel fabrication and engineering challenges. At present such a device is not available at reasonable price for widespread use throughout the globe. At present, open-vessel MAE seems to be the most convenient, simple, and rapid option for extraction of thermolabile phytoconstituents, as it does not demand any sophisticated machinery (except a simple microwave oven), as opposed to methods like ultrasonication or SFE.

Objective of the program:

Extraction is the first crucial step in preparation of plant formulations. Modern methods of extraction are effective in advancing the development of traditional herbal remedies. Sample preparation is of utmost importance to the development of analytical methods for the analysis of constituents present in the botanicals and herbal preparations.

Medicinal plants are important for discovery and identification of new therapeutic compounds. Extraction method plays an important role in separation and characterization of different phytochemicals from herbs, and screening plant extracts for novel leads. Conventional methods are exhaustive and require more time, power, sample and solvent consumption is higher than their modern counterparts.

Outcome of the program

Modern methods are amenable to high degree of automation, and several parameters can be controlled at a time. Sample and solvent consumption are also reduced by selecting the most appropriate method. A good extraction can be achieved in shorter period of time, and the recovered extract can have improved yield and quality than that prepared by a conventional method. Methods such as SFE, MAE, and UAE are better suited for the extraction of heat labile and volatile compounds, which is not the case with the conventional methods.

Former are more promising for industrial applications due to their enhanced efficiency, specificity and selectivity. Further innovations such as a Soxhlet under reduced pressure (which will bring together advantages like rapid heating due to microwave, fast boiling of solvents due to reduced pressure, and scope of solvent recovery) will in future make extraction of thermolabile plant constituents much more efficient and rapid.



Emerging pathogens have appeared in recent years, raising alerts among health authorities. Moreover, new anti-infective treatments have been discovered, and it is extremely important to know when to use them to avoid abuse and misuse of these new drugs because of possible negative antimicrobial resistance outcomes. Furthermore, new vaccines have appeared on the market, and it is essential that

practitioners be informed of their impact on public health. For these reasons, the International Journal of Molecular Sciences has decided to dedicate a Special Issue to the pathophysiology, diagnostics and prevention of infectious diseases. This Special Issue has the main goal of presenting recent advances in different aspects of infectious diseases, covering paediatric and adult issues as well as different pathogens.

The Infectious Disease Pathology Service of the Division of Surgical Pathology provides comprehensive diagnostic expertise and services relating to the pathology of bacterial, mycobacterial, fungal, and parasitic infections of all tissues and organ systems.

In addition to evaluation by conventional histology, a variety of specialized immunohistochemical and molecular tests are utilized. In close collaboration with the Clinical Microbiology Laboratory and Division of Infectious Diseases, laboratory results and clinical findings are incorporated to arrive at an integrated diagnosis for each case.

Outcome of the program

The Infectious diseases department provides clinical expertise in the diagnosis and management of unusual and complicated infections in children including tropical diseases, and with Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) infection. There are also specialist clinics for children with tuberculosis and chronic viral hepatitis. A large part of our work is around antimicrobial stewardship, a process which ensures that medicines used to treat infections are used in the best possible way across the hospital. One of the main elements of our outpatient service is dedicated to the care of children living with HIV.
