Objective of the program:

Autacoids or autocoids are biological factors which acts like local hormones, have long duration, and act near their site of biosynthesis. Autocoids also to describe synthesis, receptors and functions of histamine, ecosanoids, nitric oxide, angiotensin, kinins & 5-HT. To study the agents which enhance or block their effects Have different biological actions including modulation of the activity of smooth muscle, glands, nerves, platelets and other tissues. They have autocrine or paracrine effect, autocoids are also CNS depressants but they diminish with time. The perforce of working dose may be adversely affected. Anti-muscarnic effect occurs with many H1-with many histamines.

Outcome of the program

The technologies described here obviously represent little more than the tip of the iceberg for the development of drug delivery systems, and few of these even extend beyond the realm of benchtop experimentation. Although these approaches are the focus of intense, ongoing research, other processes are also under consideration, including aerosol inhalation devices, transdermal methodologies, forced pressure injectables, and biodegradable polymer networks designed specifically to transport new gene therapies.

Objective of the program:

Spoilage of pharmaceutical products and drugs are referred as the changes in the physical and chemical properties in such a way that the formulation or therapeutic agents gets deteriorate and become not suitable for use. • Microbial spoilage includes the contamination of pharmaceutical products with the microbes which leads to spoilage of the products affecting Drug safety and quality, and it not intended for use. • Shortly defined as deterioteration of pharmaceutical products by the contaminant microbes.

Pharmaceutical products contain a wide range of excipients in addition to active pharmaceutical ingredients for making the formula easy to manufacture, stable, effective, and convenient to the patient. These products in the pharmaceutical industry must meet high microbiological specs which means if they are not sterile, they should have not more than a minimal microbial population at the time of product release as well as afterward. If there is microbial spoilage of products then products are unsuitable for use, resulting in financial problems to the manufacturers and also a potential health hazard to the patients. Hence microbial spoilage is required to be minimized which depends on many factors affecting the microbial spoilage of pharmaceutical products. So, the ability of the formulation to protect itself from microbial growth must ascertain to determine microbial stability of the formulation. It is done by preservative efficacy test.

Electrochemical analysis is a collection of techniques that use electrical stimulation to analyze the chemical reactivity of a sample surface or a solution. Oxidation and reduction reaction rates are controlled and measured by a potentiostat, connected to electrodes submerged in an electrolyte.

There are five main electrochemical methods for the determination of drugs in clinical trials, including voltammetry, potentiometry, conductometry, amperometry, and impedimetric

Electrochemical techniques have their advantages because of their simplicity, low cost and speed. The only condition for this method of monitoring enzyme kinetics is that direct electron transfer must be possible or able to be achieved by mediators

Objectives:

The advantages of electrochemical methods are that the signal is electrical and no transformation is required for transferring the information to control units. Some of the methods are rather specific and therefore can be used to detect only the species of interest.

Outcome of the program

Improved drug delivery: Nanoparticles can be used to improve drug delivery, by increasing the drug's solubility, bioavailability, and stability. This allows for lower doses of drugs to be used, reducing the risk of toxicity and side effects. Nanomaterials have noteworthy applications in nanobiotechnology, particularly in diagnosis, drug delivery systems (Faraji and Wipf 2009), prostheses, and implants. Nanoscale materials integrate well into biomedical devices because most biological systems are also nanosized. Through the manipulation of size, surface characteristics and material used, the nanoparticles can be developed into smart systems, encasing therapeutic and imaging
