The fluoroquinolones are a family of broad spectrum, systemic antibacterial agents that have been used widely as therapy of respiratory and urinary tract infections. The emergence of more virulent and resistant strains of bacteria for drugs is considered the main problem associated with the therapeutic use of these drugs. This situation participated in designing new fluoroquinolone derivatives. Fluoroquinolone derivatives are of pivotal interest due to their admirable pharmacological and pharmacokinetic profiles. They also exhibit higher bioavailability, excellent tissue penetration and relatively low adverse and toxic effects.

Over the past years, several fluoroquinolones (FQs) were designed, synthesized and evaluated, giving rise to a number of FDA approved drugs. Recent advances and future perspectives of FQs agents as drugs in the field of chemotherapy, have guided to endeavour their anticancer activity. Put simply, to follow cGMP a company must have: Facilities that are kept in good condition; Equipment that is carefully maintained and calibrated; Employees who are qualified and fully trained and; Operating procedures that are reliable and reproducible.

cGMP applies to facilities and buildings, production, equipment, process controls, laboratory controls, packaging, and labeling, and returned or salvaged drug products.

### Objectives:

The CGMP regulations for drugs contain minimum requirements for the methods, facilities, and controls used in manufacturing, processing, and packing of a drug product. The regulations make sure that a product is safe for use, and that it has the ingredients and strength it claims to have. CGMP provides for systems that assure proper design, monitoring, and control of manufacturing processes and facilities. Adherence to the CGMP regulations assures the identity, strength, quality, and purity of drug products by requiring that manufacturers of medications adequately control manufacturing operations. Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP) is a comprehensive manufacturing system that ensures product consistency and quality by addressing 5 key components: products, people, processes, procedures, and premises.
